

March 9, 2015

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, March 9, 2015 at 7:30 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Long moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Ault seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Dick Pees from the Hardin county Sheriff's office was on hand to update the board of new from the Sheriff's office. A discussion was had regarding the township blockwatch program as well as a recent issue with dispatching about jurisdiction boundaries on a particular incident with the McGuffey Fire Co.

Mr. Ault moved to supply pizza and drinks along with a \$125 donation to the Cessna Minutemen 4H club for the clubs participation in the annual Cessna Township Cleanup Day that is scheduled for Saturday, April 4th. Mr. Long seconded with all voting aye.

The 4H club will be picking up trash along the township roads while dumpsters for scrap iron and other waste material will be made available for all township residents.

The state auditor's office is nearing completion of the audit of the township records for 2013 and 2014.

Mr. Schwemer presented his zoning update.

The board reviewed the list of road projects that have been estimated for completion by the Hardin county Engineer's office and Mr. Long motioned to approve the following projects to be completed by the county engineer under "force account" for 2015.
