

July 13, 2015

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, July 13, 2015 at 7:30 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr.Hull moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Ault seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Mark Schwemer updated the board on zoning activity.

John and Lori Steinman were present to inquire about the condition of the Dean Tracy property located on TR 125. Mr. Steinman presented overhead aerial maps he obtained from Google Earth Maps that showed numerous vehicles over all parts of the property. Mr. Steinman asked if the township zoning laws permitted the amount of seemingly "junk vehicles" that the pictures indicate? After much discussion between the trustees, zoning officer, and the Steinmans, the option of pursuing the Junk Vehicle Ordinance that was adopted by the Cessna Township Board of Trustees on April 14, 2008 (Resolution #2008-03) to deal with such vehicles was discussed as a more viable option. Mr. Long then moved to pursue the issue on the Tracy property using the above mentioned Junk Vehicle Ordinance. Mr. Hull seconded the motion with all voting aye. Mr. Schwemer was asked to start the process as soon as possible.
