The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in special session on Saturday, March 19, 2016 at 8:00 A.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present.

Discussion between the zoning officer and the board of trustees was heard in regards to the Dean Tracy property on TR 125. After discussion, Mr. Ault moved the following:

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-05**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE HARDIN COUNTY PROSECUTOR TO PURSUE LEGAL ACTION TO ABATE NUISANCES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP.**

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees of Cessna Township, Hardin County, Ohio have determined that vegetation, garbage, refuse and other debris have accumulated on the property located at 10009, Township Road 125, Kenton, Ohio 43326, which is within the unincorporated area of the Township, in violation of Ohio Revised Code 505.87; and

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees of Cessna Township, Hardin County, Ohio have determined that junk motor vehicles have accumulated on the property located at 10009, Township Road 125, Kenton, Ohio 43326, which is within the unincorporated area of the Township, in violation of Ohio Revised Code 505.871 and 505.173; and

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees of Cessna Township, Ohio have provided notice under the Ohio Revised Code to the property owner and any lien holder of the violations, and

**WHEREAS**, the property owner and/or lien holder have failed to abate the conditions that have given rise to the violations within the time permitted under the Ohio Revised Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRUSTEES OF CESSNA TOWNSHIP, HARDIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION I.** The Trustees of Cessna Township, Ohio hereby requests that the Hardin County Prosecutor to file suit in the Hardin County Common Pleas Court requesting an Order abating the nuisance conditions and statutory violations that exist on the property located at 10009 Township Road 125, Kenton, Ohio, 43326.

**SECTION II.** That this Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
