

February 13, 2017

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, February 13, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Hull moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Ault seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Mark Schwemer was on hand to update the board on zoning issues. He indicated that Sheldon Moseman, 9977 Township Road 115, had inquired about erecting barns to house chickens on his property. Mr. Moseman was given the zoning requirements for such a facility. Wendell Martin, 9025 State Route 309, was advised on regulations for placing a sign in front of his property advertising his meat cutting business.

The trustee’s were given a demonstration on the new Cessna Township Website. The website is up and running, and additional information will continue to be installed.

Mr. Ault made the motion to accept the estimate from the Hardin County Engineer’s office to replace various signs around the township as recommended. Mr. Long seconded with all voting aye.

The trustee’s will meet with the Hardin County Engineer on April 5, 2017 at 12:50 pm to review the upcoming summer road projects.

Mr. Ault moved to contract with Don Hull Tree Care to remove dead Ash trees in the road right of way at a total cost not to exceed \$7,000. Mr. Long seconded with Mr. Ault and Mr. Long voting aye. Mr. Hull abstained.

The board discussed the possible paving of the township parking lot. The trustee’s will seek a second estimate from Quality Paving to compare with the estimate already received from the county engineer.

A phone call was made to Todd Motter to discuss the renewal of mowing of township cemeteries for 2017. Mr. Ault moved to renew the contract for 3 years with an increase of \$50 per mowing. Mr. Hull seconded with all voting aye. Mr. Motter agreed to the proposal and a contract will be drawn.

The board reviewed the recent situation of finding dead hogs in the ditch on TR74. The hogs were disposed of per the guidance of the Hardin County Health Sanitarian.
