

November 13, 2017

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, November 13, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Long moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Ault seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Newly elected trustee’s Craig Eibling and Chris Vermillion were present.

Mark Schwemer was on hand to give his zoning report to the board. Mr. Schwemer noted that no activity has taken place at the “triangle property” on CR 90 since the last letter was sent regarding the junk vehicle and trash on the property. The trustees instructed Mr. Schwemer to proceed with the proper procedures to start the cleanup process according to advice from the county prosecutor using ORC 505.871 and ORC 505.173.

The Fiscal Officer noted that the township was in receipt of a grant award from the North Central Ohio Solid Waste District in the amount of \$207.20 to offset the cost of the April 2017 annual township cleanup event.

Mr. Ault moved to send an invoice for the cold patch that was used to repair the damage in front of the John Point property

Discussion was heard in regards to a possible Issue II project on TR 105. An estimate from the Hardin County Engineer’s office for the removal of a hill on TR105 just South of the township hall was received in the amount of \$44,000. Mr. Long has spoken with Mark Doll from the regional planning office about the project with Mr. Doll suggesting that the Cessna Township project possibly considered as a joint Issue II application with a possible project that Jackson Township is considering. Mr. Long moved to proceed with the project with Mr. Hull seconding the motion. All voted aye. Mr. Doll will be contacted by the Fiscal Officer to discuss the next steps in the grant application.

Mr. Long updated the board on the ongoing discussion that the BKP board has been having with the city of Kenton. He indicated that the city was considering the purchase of a used ambulance for use of the fire department to transport patients. Other discussions were being heard about some type of consolidation of services between BKP and the city but no proposals were currently beyond the discussion phases.

The trustees also noted that a downed tree on TR74 had been cleared.
