

November 12, 2018

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, November 12th at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Eibling moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Long seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Mr. Vermillion moved to accept the budget modifications to the cemetery fund due to increased mowing costs as explained by the fiscal officer. Mr. Long seconded with all voting aye.

It was noted that the Marathon Pipeline Company has asked the trustees for permission to install a guard rail on North side TR 90 at the pipeline pump station. After the trustee's reviewed the right of ways Mr. Long moved to allow the installation of the guardrail as long as it is located between the utility pole and the chain link fence. Mr. Eibling seconded with all voting aye.

Mr. Eibling moved to approve a two year agreement with Bill Legge to perform grave opening and closing services for the township in 2019 and 2020 as presented. Mr. Vermillion seconded with all voting aye.

Mr. Legge has also presented a fix for standing water on the western portion of TR100. His repair will also include drainage work on the property owned by Larry Ludwig to provide a place for the water to dissipate. It was agreed that the total bill for repairs should be split between the township and Mr. Ludwig since both parties would benefit from the repairs. Mr. Vermillion moved to proceed with the project only if Mr. Ludwig agrees to pay his share of \$650. Mr. Eibling seconded the motion with all voting aye.

A discussion was heard regarding a possible change to the Cessna Township Cemetery regulations about the placement of military plaques. The fiscal officer will seek out other townships policies on this and report back.
