

April 08, 2019

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, April 08 2019 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Vermillion moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Eibling seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Mr. Schwemer was on hand to provide his zoning report. He stated that Lois Ann Sheldon has submitted her resignation as a Cessna Township Zoning Board of Appeals member. Mr. Long motioned to accept Mrs. Sheldon’s resignation with regrets and Mr. Vermillion seconded. All voted aye. The board thanked Mrs. Sheldon for her many years of service to Cessna Township.

Mr. Schwemer also discussed the ongoing issue with the building that is out of compliance on the Sally Rupe property. Mr. Vermillion motioned for the zoning officer to send written notice to the property owner that the hardship permit that Mrs. Rupe’s daughter indicated that she would be applying for will need to be submitted prior to July 01, 2019. If the hardship application is not received by 7/1/19 the building on the property in question will need to be removed by August 1, 2019. Mr. Long seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Wendell Martin was on hand to ask about a zoning permit for a planned new home that he will be building. He also was seeking permission from the board to extend a culvert on TR 105 for a new driveway. Mr. Schwemer will help Mr. Martin with the building permit and the board approved the culvert work as explained.

It was noted that a family member was questioning who had placed a stone on his mother’s grave site in Fulton Cemetery. The trustees informed the family member that the stone placement was not a function of the trustees and that he should check with his other family members.
