

March 11, 2019

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, March 11 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Vermillion moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Long seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Mr. Schwemer was on hand to provide his zoning report.

Katrina Dillon and Larry Ludwig were present to discuss the zoning issue with the cabin placement at the residence of Sally Rupe on TR 105. Katrina Dillon, Sally Rupe’s daughter, inquired about the process for application of “hardship” in order to keep the cabin at its current location. Mr. Schwemer was instructed to provide the details. Ms. Dillon stated that she intended to pursue this option. The trustees informed her that she would need to work with the zoning officer in a timely manner or the cabin would need to be removed.

The trustees discussed the upcoming township cleanup day scheduled for April 6, 2019. An attempt will be made to get volunteers to pick up roadside trash.

Mr. Long noted that a downed tree on TR 74 was recently removed.
