

April 11, 2022

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, April 11, 2022 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr.Vermillion moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Hull seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Mark Schwemer, Zoning Officer, gave his zoning report to the board.

The board reviewed recommendations from the recent OTARMA on site insurance visit. This includes having all township fire extinguishers inspected. The fiscal officer will schedule the service.

The board also reviewed the results of the Ground Penetrating Radar report for Salem Cemetery that was just completed. The radar search noted that no conclusive evidence of unmarked graves were found in the front sections of the cemetery. The board has agreed to pursue more information in mapping out the front of the cemetery to create more lot space.

It was noted that the Cessna Township Annual Spring Cleanup day was held on Saturday, April 2, 2022.

The board also accepted the resignation of Jim Gossard as the Summer road mower. Mr. Gossard has done a great job of performing road mowing for Cessna Township since August of 2021. Mr. Hull moved to present Mr. Gossard with a \$250 gift card as appreciation for his years of service. Mr. Eibling seconded with all voting aye.
