

December 13, 2021

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Eibling moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Vermillion seconded the motion with all voting aye.

The board recognized Hardin County Common Pleas judge candidate Christina Cross. Ms. Cross gave a brief presentation and passed out campaign literature.

Discussion was heard about the 2022 budget. Money will be appropriated for the possible purchase of a new tractor as well as repairs to cemetery monuments. Final appropriations will be made available at the January regular meeting.

Resolution #2021-06

Whereas: The Cessna Township Board of Trustees agree to set the compensation rate for the trustees in 2022 to be set at the maximum daily rate allowed by the Ohio Revised Code, not to exceed 200 days per year with 2/3rd's of the salary coming from the Gas Fund and the remaining 1/3rd to be paid from the General fund based upon the percentage of time spent.

Wetherefore: After review, agree to the rates and days of service as presented.

BeItResolved: Mr. Hull motions to approve the resolution with Mr. Vermillion seconding.

Roll Call Vote : Mr. Hull Yes, Mr. Vermillion Yes, Mr. Eibling Yes. Resolution Adopted

Mr.Hull moved to hold the annual organizational meeting at the township hall on Monday, January 10, 2022 at 7:00 pm with the January regular meeting to immediately follow. Mr. Eibling seconded with all voting aye.

Mr. Schwemer gave his monthly zoning report.

The Fiscal Officer presented the final budget modifications for 2021 along with the final certificate of estimated resources to be submitted to the county auditor. Mr. Vermillion moved to accept both reports with Mr. Hull seconding. All voted aye.

The board agreed to invite Todd Motter to the 1/10/22 meeting to discuss a new cemetery mowing contract.

The board also contacted Charles Hensel in regards to an estimate for removing the old window style air conditioning units from the township hall and permanently enclosing the openings.
