

February 14, 2022

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, February 14, 2022 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Vermillion moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Eibling seconded the motion with all voting aye.

The board heard from Maria Santo, candidate for Hardin County Common Pleas Court Judge. Fire Chief Jerry Ault was present to give the board a recap of McGuffey Volunteer Fire Department activities for 2021. He also delivered bills for 2022.

Mark Schwemer, Zoning Officer, gave his zoning report to the board. Discussion was had regarding an offer from the Hardin County Regional Planning office to provide funding to townships that have houses that are in need of razing. The program requires the land owner to approve of the demolition, but allows the property owner to retain ownership of the land. Mr. Schwemer will contact landowners that have properties that fit this description and offer the service to them.

Mr. Vermillion moved to accept the quote from Adam Haudenschild Tree Service to remove a dead tree in the township right of way on TR80 for \$900 along with a dead tree in Fort McArthur Cemetery for \$1,000 as presented. Mr. Eibling seconded with all voting aye.

Mr. Eibling moved and Mr. Hull seconded a motion to pay the invoice from Jerry Ault for his assistance in snow removal during the recent snowstorm. Mr. Ault used his tractor and snowblower to remove deep snow from various roads. All voted aye.

Mr. Hull moved to approve a two year contract with Bill Legge to continue providing grave open and closing services for the township at the same rates and conditions of the prior contract as presented. Mr. Eibling seconded with all voting aye.

The board discussed the 2022 road programs and requested estimates from the Hardin County Engineer for various projects. Estimates will be reviewed at the March meeting.
