

February 10, 2025

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, February 10th, 2025 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and trustees Hull and Vermillion present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Vermillion moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Hull seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Mark Schwemer presented his monthly zoning update.

Todd Motter was on hand to talk with the board about his mowing contract that expired on 12/31/2024. The board suggested a new contract commencing on April 1, 2025 through December 31, 2027 with a total increase of \$25 per mowing with all other details of the contract remaining the same as the old. Mr. Vermillion made motion with Mr. Hull seconding. All voted aye.

The expired grave opening and closing contract between the township and Bill Legge was extended at the same rates for 2024 and 2025. Mr. Hull moved to accept the new contract with Mr. Vermillion seconding. Motion passed with all approving.

Mr. Vermillion moved to again employ Clayton Jackson as the township road mower for 2025. Mr. Hull seconded with all voting aye.

The board reviewed potential projects for the 2025 road program in anticipation of meeting with the Hardin County Engineer. The board will ask for pricing on chip/seal on the following roads using # 8 stone:

- TR 105 from 90 to 701
- TR 87 from 80 to 701
- TR 80 from 85 to 115
- TR 80 from 115 to 135

Mr. Vermillion moved to conduct the annual township cleanup day on Saturday April 5, 2025 in conjunction with an open house for residents to tour the new equipment building. Mr. Hull seconded with all voting aye.

A second estimate was received from J&B HVAC Plumbing and Electrical for the labor only to install the township provided radiant tube heating system in the new building. After reviewing this estimate as compared to the total install estimate from Quality Mechanical, Mr. Vermillion motioned to accept the proposal for the township to purchase the materials from Schilling Propane that will be installed by J&B. Mr. Hull seconded with all voting aye. This is anticipated to save the township over \$10,000.
