**Resolution to place a renewal levy of 1.00 mill on the November 3, 2020 ballot for the purpose of Cessna Township Cemetery Levy:**

Mr. Vermillion moved the adoption of the following resolution:

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Cessna Township for the purpose of 1.0 mills renewal levy for the purpose of maintaining and operating cemeteries for 5 years that is necessary to levy in excess of the 10 mill limitations for the General Levy per O.R.C. Section 5705.19 (T) beginning 1/1/2021 and expiring tax year 2025. The 1.0 mill renewal levy to be placed on the November 3, 2020 general election.

**Resolution to place a renewal levy of 1.00 mill on the November 3, 2020 ballot for the purpose of Cessna Township Fire Protection Levy:**

Mr. Eibling moved the adoption of the following resolution.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Cessna Township for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section [145.48](#) or [742.34](#) of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs; for 5 years that is necessary to levy in excess of the 10 mill limitations for the General Levy per O.R.C. Section 5705.19 (I) beginning 1/1/2021 and expiring tax year 2025. The 1.0 mill renewal levy to be placed on the November 3, 2020 general election. The levy type is a renewal.
