The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, July 11, 2022 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Eibling moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Hull seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Discussion was heard regarding limb and tree cleanup from the recent windstorm. The trustees were able to remove all limbs and trees from the roadways on their own but discussed contacting Adam Haudenschild tree service about some limbs that need to be trimmed.

It was also noted that the hot mix scratch coating portion of the summer road projects on TR 87, 100 and 125 have been completed by the Hardin County Engineer.

The John Deere tractor hydraulic oil leak has been repaired with the replacement of a cracked hydraulic pump.
