The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Saturday, March 15th, 2025 at 8:00 A.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Vermillion moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Hull seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Colleen O’Connell was present to discuss her candidacy for Hardin County Municipal Court Judge in the May 06, 2025 primary. The board wished her luck and thanked her for her presentation.

Mark Schwemer presented his monthly zoning update. He noted that he had received a new building permit from Corey Ludwig and welcomed Wendell Martin who was on hand to apply for a building permit that would expand his butcher shop.

The board reviewed estimates for potential projects for the 2025 road program from the Hardin County Engineer. The estimates include various hot mix wedging.
