

October 19, 2020

The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, October 20, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and all trustees present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Eibling moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Hull seconded the motion with all voting aye.

Larry Ludwig was present to share information about the flooding on TR 100. The trustee’s will further investigate the issue.

Jerry Ault, McGuffey Volunteer Fire Department Chief, was on hand to solicit the board for assistance to the department in obtaining a MARCS radio grant for the department use. He indicated that the fire department was ineligible to apply for the grant because it is a private company, not a governmental agency. However, the township can apply for this grant and provide the radios to MVFD as long as the company is under contract with the township. The grant provides the funding for the purchase of the radios but will not provide for the monthly service fees after the grant expires. After much discussion Mr. Eibling moved to apply for the MARCS radio grant and to allow the McGuffey Volunteer Fire Company the use of the radios as long as the MFVD agrees to pay the township any future service fees for them. Mr. Vermillion seconded the motion with all voting aye. It was noted that the current fire contract between the township and MVFD will be expiring at the end of 2020 and that language about the MARCS radios be placed in the new agreement.

The board also reviewed a request from the North Central Ohio Solid Waste District to change the fee structure on each ton of waste generated within the district. The board agreed to table the request until more clarification in the proposed changes could be heard. The fiscal officer will seek further information for action to be taken up again at the November meeting.
