The board of Cessna Township Trustees opened in regular session on Monday, September 09, 2024 at 7:00 P.M. at the township hall with the fiscal officer and trustees Vermillion and Eibling present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read along with the presentation of the monthly financial reports. Mr. Eibling moved to accept all reports as presented. Mr. Vermillion seconded the motion with all voting aye.

The board welcomed two guests. Fred Rush, Hardin County Commissioner, addressed the board. He indicated that he was running for reelection to the January 3rd 2025 term and would appreciate the boards support. He updated the board on recent activities in the commissioner's office. Joe Sherman, current Goshen Township Trustee, running for the January 2nd 2025 open commissioner's seat was also on hand to seek his support. The trustees thanked both gentlemen for attending and expressed to both, there concerns about the uncertain future of the Hardin County Health Department and the need for a county wide EMA system.

Mark Schwemer gave his monthly zoning report.

Resolution #2024-07

Whereas: Mr. Richard Pees has reached the end of his term as a member of the Cessna township zoning board and is still an eligible resident of the township.

Wetherefore: Nominate Mr. Pees to a five year term as a member of the Board of Appeals expiring 12/31/2027

After review Mr. Vermillion moved to proceed with the estimate from Rish Masonary for \$13,036 as the best and lowest bid received. Mr. Eibling seconded with all voting aye.
